Australia's greatest ever golfer, Karrie Webb, jetted in from Florida on Sunday, March 20 to be at Black Bull Golf Club the next day then Yarrawonga Mulwala Golf Club Resort on the Tuesday.


"Victoria is blessed with so many amazing golf courses, but the Murray region is so unique for me," Karrie told the Yarrawonga Chronicle.

At Black Bull, Karrie, Bree and Paul played the three holes comprising 'The Bull Ring' (Par 3 fourth hole, Par 4, fifth and Par 4 sixth hole) followed by the 18th Par 5 hole with the green just metres from Lake Mulwala.

"She's the best Australian ever," Black Bull head professional James McCully commented to the Yarrawonga Chronicle about Karrie.

"Seven majors to her name, a World Number One - she's done everything possible in women's golf and now taking on a career in marketing and promotion. Karrie is the 'Rolls Royce' of Golf. They loved our golf course, The Sebel and Lake Mulwala.

"It was great having Karrie, Bree and Paul, and of course the production team here to showcase just what Yarrawonga has."
